## 7. Project specific objective:

- Increasing the safety and protection of the population in the eligible area by improving the intervention capacity of the public authorities with responsibilities in the field of emergency situations;
- Enhancing the intervention in emergency situations of the public authorities through joint trainings and common cooperation framework.
